



Minimally Invasive Organ Transplant Consensus Conference (MIOT.CC)
12-14 December 2024, Riyadh, Saudi Arabia

PROJECT SUMMARY

The **Minimally Invasive Organ Transplant Consensus Conference (MIOT.cc)** is hosted by the Organ Transplant Center of Excellence at King Faisal Specialist Hospital in Riyadh and led by Prof. Dieter Broering, in collaboration with Prof. Enrico Benedetti from the University of Illinois Hospital, Chicago, USA.

- **Day One:** Focus on live minimally invasive demonstrations, allowing attendees to witness first-hand the cutting-edge surgical practices in real time.
- **Day Two:** Dedicated to forming a consensus on liver and kidney transplantation, with renowned experts leading discussions and debates on current practices and future directions.
- **Day Three:** Expands the discussion to include pancreas, lung, heart, and uterus transplantation, broadening the scope of the conference to encompass a wide array of organ transplantations.

Following the **Danish Model of Consensus**, the conference will bridge the gap between current practices and expert opinions. Working groups will deliberate on specific questions, engage in rigorous debates with both experts and the audience, allow voting, and prepare statements. These will be reviewed by an independent jury of non-experts who will then issue the final recommendations.

The outcomes of the MIOT.cc will be crucial in forming unified, internationally recognized **guidelines** for minimally invasive organ transplantation. These proceedings will be documented and **published**, offering PubMed citable **authorship** to all collaborators and ensuring that their contributions are acknowledged within the medical community.

We invite **all stakeholders** in the field of organ transplantation to join us in Riyadh for this landmark conference, which promises to set new standards and contribute significantly to the global field on advancing transplant medicine.
